In *Spes Non Confundit*, the Bull proclaiming the Jubilee Year, he reminded us: "Hope does not disappoint" (Romans 5:5). We are called to rediscover the steadfast hope that flows from a personal encounter with Christ, and to offer this gift to a world in need.

I knew from the first session that I was dealing with a program for middle school girls that was different, when during one of our early meetings I saw a very still, quiet, curious, and inspired look rest on the faces of the ten girls in our group when they heard the words, "If you cannot lose God's love, you cannot earn God's love." The fruits: these girls fell in love with their Bibles, walked happily into our meetings week after week, internalized truths about themselves, and had the courage to challenge lies. I even heard that one girl, in a

counseling session, told her counselor that a coping skill she could use was, "Read my Bible," then ran to get it and shared passages that had been inspiring her. I am grateful for BLAZE. It truly meets middle school girls right where they are, and you can see it in their faces.


#### **Parish-based Programs**

#### **Global Reach**

To further our mission, women who are active duty military members and spouses are eligible for free WWP Bible study guides and coach support at their bases. *The Kate W. McDonald Memorial Military Scholarship—Hope in the Trenches* celebrates, strengthens, and rewards active duty military members and spouses.

Military-based Walking with Purpose groups are spread across the globe, including women from Hawaii, South Korea, Georgia, Texas, Alabama, California, New Mexico, Germany, Wyoming, Oklahoma, Massachusetts, Japan, and Colorado.



### Program Highlights Virtual Groups

Offering women a flexible, welcoming way to grow in faith and community from anywhere. With new affinity groups and a teen-focused Sisters of Strength group in 2025, there is a place for every woman and girl to belong.

#### Virtual Affinity Group Snapshots

- **General:** A virtual group open to all women seeking to grow in faith, healing, and wholeness. No specific life stage or experience is required to participate.
- **Moms:** A group for women currently raising children under the age of 18. Discussion and support center around the experiences of motherhood.
- **Military:** Designed for active duty or retired military women and their spouses. Content and conversation reflect the unique challenges of military life.
- **Widows:** A group for women who have experienced the loss of a spouse. Provides space for connection and shared understanding in the grieving process.
- **Singles:** For women who are single and seeking faith-based connection. Participants share similar life experiences and explore spiritual growth together.
- **Sisters of Strength:** A new virtual group for high school girls. Focuses on faith, friendship, identity, and purpose during the teen years.

### **Program Highlights** Heart of Vines

One of our most exciting endeavors from this past fiscal year has been the launch of *Heart of Vines* in February 2025. Created for the young woman who is searching for purpose and exploring her spirituality, this program is a gentle and affirming guide for believers and skeptics alike, which is available as a book or digital masterclass.

What makes *Heart of Vines* truly special, and perhaps one of our greatest hopes for it, is that it reaches far beyond women in their 20s. This is a resource for every woman who longs to understand the challenges our young people face today, to step into their world with empathy, and to be equipped with a narrative that allows them to grab hold of their hands.

*Heart of Vines* is more than a program—it is an invitation to meaningful connection across generations. Whether used in small groups, mentoring relationships, or personal reflection, it opens the door for honest conversations about faith, identity, and belonging. As women journey through the content together, we've seen bridges built between mothers and daughters, parish leaders and college students, seasoned believers and those just beginning to ask life's big questions. This shared experience of seeking and storytelling is what makes *Heart of Vines* truly transformative.

### **Program Highlights BLAZE and Sisters of Strength**

**BLAZE**, our ministry for tween/teen girls, and **Sisters of Strength**, for teens, are pillars in our apostolate's vision of passing on the torch of faith to the next generation. What better time to capture a young girl's heart than before she ever leaves the faith, equipping her with the skills to counter the lies of the world with the truths found from God?

This year, BLAZE received a beautiful update, specifically designed with young girls in mind, to capture their attention with something they'd find inspiring. While the content remains the same, the new look stays true to our classic WWP brand while also being visually appealing to tween girls.

Since the release of Sisters of Strength last April, over **205 leaders** have answered the call to bring Sisters of Strength to their communities. In fact, about fifty of our former BLAZE leaders have now started leading Sisters of Strength with their girls, as they transition from middle school to high school. It is their hope, and our prayer, that teen girls might be empowered to recognize their preciousness in the eyes of God, know their unconditional worth, and form authentic friendships.




